Getting your Flu or Covid-19 vaccination

	Lots of people may get COVID-19 or Flu this winter. They are both viruses that makes you feel ill.
	Some people with a learning disability are more likely to be very ill if they get COVID-19 or Flu.
	The best way to avoid getting the viruses is to have the COVID-19 and Flu vaccines. These are given as injections and are both free.
GP Surgery Pharmacy	You can get both your vaccinations from your GP Practice or at some local pharmacies.
